CAP EXPO 2016

Open Gardens Canberra attended its *second* Connect And Participate EXPO on 19 March this year. CAP EXPOs are sponsored by the ACT Government so that the people of the Canberra region can get to know the huge range of interests being pursued by community organisations.

This year three members volunteered to tell everyone about Open Gardens Canberra. We spoke to about 180 people, including about 7 of our members, and we engaged with about 20 gardeners of the future, ie children.

Last year the EXPO was held on 31 March, 38 days before Open Gardens Canberra became an incorporated association. At the time of the EXPO, we had three members and five people volunteered to help on the day! At the EXPO 62 people signed up to our email list and almost all of them subsequently joined. We displayed an A3 poster for every garden opened or still to open in the 2015-16 season.
